CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- COMPLETION OF OUR ONLINE ENTRY FORM and payment by Paypal is preferred. Please go to our Scottish Salon website <u>www.scottish-photographic-salon.org</u>
- This Exhibition is run within FIAP, RPS, PAGB and PSA recommended procedures and regulations. Please also see their definition statements below.
- There are SIX separate Sections THREE PRINT Open Monochrome (PSA Large Print), Open Colour (PSA Large Print), Nature (PSA ND); AND THREE PROJECTED DIGITAL IMAGE Open Monochrome (PID Mono), Open Colour (PID Color), Nature (PSA ND) Monochrome images are ineligible in colour sections.
- The exhibition is open to anyone; however, an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organisation or its agent, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to Exhibition rules and conditions.
- Entries are limited to not more than 4 images per section, category or class per author. An entrant's four images will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging in that section.
- Each photograph must have a unique title.
- Each entrant will receive a printed colour catalogue, whether or not they have any works accepted.
- There are awards for the Best Scottish Club and for The Best Club from outwith Scotland.
- PROJECTED DIGITAL IMAGES <u>must</u> be entered via our website upload ONLINE ENTRY ONLY; Maximum Image size 1400 pixels horizontal and 1050 pixels vertical at 300ppi in jpeg format. The colour space sRGB or AdobeRGB1998.
- Image Filename You do not need to number or change the filename before uploading in to our online system The Title you enter in the box supplied will be the title for that image – Please ensure that you enter it how you wish it to appear in the Catalogue. Our projection background is black.
- **PRINTS** must not exceed **500x400 mm**, **UNMOUNTED** is preferred. Overseas prints MUST be unmounted.
- Each entry must show author's name, title and number as per the manual entry form/ online entry form. No title or
 identification of the maker shall be written anywhere on the face of an image, print mat or mount. Only pressure sensitive
 (self-adhesive) labels may be used on the backs of unmounted prints.
- Overseas Entrants Maximum weight of packages not to exceed 2 kilos. Entries should be sent with customs labels stating - 'Photographs for exhibition only' 'To be returned to sender' 'NO COMMERCIAL VALUE'
- NATURE SECTIONS Images to be considered for the Wildlife Medal must be marked "W" in the column to the right of the title on the entry form by the entrant as certification that the photograph so designated complies with both the general nature and the authentic wildlife definitions (See Below)
- The same image may not be entered in more than one section in the same year irrespective of media, mono or colour.
- Photographs that have been accepted for previous Scottish Salons or which are so similar as to be indistinguishable from previous acceptances are ineligible.
- Images entered must be entirely the work of the photographer. Composite images are permitted provided all
 component images meet this requirement. For the avoidance of doubt, use of images from any other source
 including, but not limited to, royalty free image banks and clipart are not permitted.
- By virtue of submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as his own (aliases are not permitted) and permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication and /or display in media related to the exhibition. This may include low resolution posting on a website. The exhibition assumes no liability for any misuse of copyright.
- The organisers will take all possible care but cannot accept liability for damage to or loss of entries.
- By the sole act of submitting his/her images or files to a salon under FIAP Patronage, the entrant accepts without exception and with no objection the following terms:
 - that the submitted images can be investigated by FIAP to establish if these obey to FIAP regulations and definitions even if the entrant is not a member of FIAP,
 - that FIAP will use any means at its disposal for this undertaking,

- that any refusal to cooperate with FIAP or any refusal to submit the original files as captured by the camera, or failure to provide sufficient evidence, will be sanctioned by FIAP,

- that in case of sanctions following non-compliance with FIAP regulations, the name of the entrant will be released in any form useful to inform the breaches of the rules,

As mentioned in II.2) It is recommended to leave the EXIF data in the submitted files intact in order to ease eventual investigations.

- Submission of entries implies acceptance of these conditions
- There is an Entry Fee for each section (see table). Entries received without fee will not be judged and no further cost will be incurred until the appropriate fee is received.
- Club Entries Please see our website for full details if entering as a group. Club Entries are accepted at £1.00 (2 Euros/US \$2) per photograph minimum remittance £20.00 (40 Euros/US \$40) PLUS RETURN POSTAGE as per the rate below. Please note all report cards, catalogues will be returned to the one address, as will the entries unless asked to forward to another exhibition. Please use a separate entry form for each author; photocopies are acceptable.
- NOTE WE ARE HAPPY FOR GROUPS OF INDIVIDUALS to enter as a group to save on costs, even if YOU are not a Club. Just enter as a 'GROUP' on our Website and leave the name of the Club/Group blank. You do not however qualify for the club award unless you are a bone fida Club.
- UK Entrants Cheques made payable to 'SCOTTISH PHOTOGRAPHIC FEDERATION (SALON A/C)'. PayPal available online only.
- Overseas Entrants Payment via our Website by Paypal is preferred. Alternatively Bank notes will be accepted with prints – We cannot accept Foreign/Euro Cheques or Coins.
- Postage must be included for all Print entries, unless you do not wish your entry to be returned, or you wish your entry to be forwarded to Edinburgh or Northern Counties. Entries will <u>not be returned</u> unless sufficient postage is received. Entries not returned will be destroyed. (Please Note Prints will be returned Surface mail except to Europe)

All entries shall conform to the stricter of these definitions for acceptances to be validated by

the International Organizations granting recognition for patronage. COMBINED FIAP. PSA. PAGB & RPS NATURE PHOTOGRAPHY DEFINITION

NATURE PHOTOGRAPHY is restricted to the use of the photographic process to depict all branches of natural history, except anthropology and archaeology, in such a fashion that a well-informed person will be able to identify the subject material and certify its honest presentation. The story telling value of a photograph must be weighed more than the pictorial quality while maintaining high technical quality. Human elements shall not be present, except where those human elements are integral parts of the nature story such as nature subjects, like barn owls or storks, adapted to an environment modified by humans, or where those human elements are in situations depicting natural forces, like hurricanes or tidal waves. Scientific bands, scientific tags or radio collars on wild animals are permissible. Photographs of human created hybrid plants, cultivated plants, feral animals, domestic animals, or mounted specimens are ineligible, as is any form of manipulation that alters the truth of the photographic statement.

No techniques that add, relocate, replace, or remove pictorial elements except by cropping are permitted. Techniques that enhance the presentation of the photograph without changing the nature story or the pictorial content, or without altering the content of the original scene, are permitted including HDR, focus stacking and dodging/burning. Techniques that remove elements added by the camera, such as dust spots, digital noise, and film scratches, are allowed. Stitched images are not permitted. All allowed adjustments must appear natural. Colour images can be converted to greyscale monochrome. Infrared images, either direct-captures or derivations, are not allowed.

Images used in Nature Photography competitions may be divided in two classes: Nature and Wildlife. Images entered in Nature sections meeting the Nature Photography Definition above can have landscapes, geologic formations, weather phenomena, and extant organisms as the primary subject matter. This includes images taken with the subjects in controlled conditions, such as zoos, game farms, botanical gardens, aquariums and any enclosure where the subjects are totally dependent on man for food.

Images entered in Wildlife sections meeting the Nature Photography Definition above are further defined as one or more extant zoological or botanical organisms free and unrestrained in a natural or adopted habitat. Landscapes, geologic formations, photographs of zoo or game farm animals, or of any extant zoological or botanical species taken under controlled conditions are not eligible in Wildlife sections. Wildlife is not limited to animals, birds and insects. Marine subjects and botanical subjects (including fungi and algae) taken in the wild are suitable wildlife subjects, as are carcasses of extant species. Wildlife images may be entered in Nature sections of Exhibitions.

FIAP DEFINITIONS

MONOCHROME - A black and white work fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey. A black and white work toned entirely in a single colour will remain a monochrome work able to stand in the black and white category; such a work can be reproduced in black and white in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage. On the other hand a black and white work modified by a partial toning or by the addition of one colour becomes a colour work (polychrome) to stand in the colour category; such a work requires colour reproduction in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage.

PSA STATEMENTS AND DEFINITIONS

"The exhibition is open to anyone; however, an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization, or its agent, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to exhibition rules and conditions. Entries are limited to not more than 4 images per section, category or class. An entrant's four images will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging in that section. Entries must originate as photographs (image-captures of objects via light sensitivity) made by the entrant on photographic emulsion or acquired digitally. By virtue of submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as his own (aliases are not permitted). The entrant permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication and/or display in media related to the exhibition. This may include low resolution posting on a website. Note: Entrants who indicate that their images may not be reproduced or used "will not be eligible for awards" or inclusion in audio-visuals of the exhibition **"and could be subjected to disqualification" by the exhibition sponsors.** The exhibition assumes no liability for any misuse of copyright. Images may be altered, either digitally or otherwise, by the maker. Artwork or computer graphics **created by the entrant** may be incorporated if the photographic content predominates; subject to nature, Photo Travel and Photojournalism divisional restrictions. All final work must be photographic film, or on electronic file, or on photographic or electronic print material, mounting excepted. No title or identification of the maker shall be visible anywhere on the face of an image, print mat or mount entered in a PSA Recognised exhibition.

Each image must have a unique title. Once an image has been accepted in a PSA Recognised exhibition, that same title, or a like "in camera" or a "reproduction" duplicate of that image:

May not be re-entered in any section of the same Division Star Ratings class in that exhibition regardless of media, format or title.
 May not be re-titled for entry in any other PSA Recognized exhibition.

Words such as "Untitled" and "No Title" are not acceptable as part or all of an Image's title, nor are camera capture filenames.

The entrant must sign the entry submittal form in the space provided to verify authorization for the exhibition to destroy the exhibitor's prints in lieu of returning them otherwise the full entry fee shall apply if the exhibition does have separate fees for return of prints and non-return of prints. **MONOCHROME** – An image is considered to be Monochrome only if it gives the impression of having no color (i.e. contains only shades of gray which can include pure black and pure white) OR it gives the impression of being a greyscale image that has been toned in one color across the entire image. (For example by Sepia, red, gold etc.) A grayscale or mutil-coloured image modified or giving the impression of having been modified by partial toning, multi toning or by the inclusion of spot coloring does not meet the definition of monochrome and shall be classed as Color Work. **CREATIVE PHOTOGRAPHY** is defined as "altered reality".

AWARDS

As approval from PSA, FIAP, RPS, PAGB, GPU and SPF is granted; For each section the following Awards will be presented by the Judges – PSA, FIAP, RPS, PAGB, GPU & SPF Medals and Ribbons, and Honourable Mentions. In addition to the above awards the 'FIAP Best Author Award' will be presented to the author with the highest combined score from all of the SIX Sections.

A special award will be made to the **Best Club UK Entry from outwith Scotland**, and the **Best Club from outwith the UK** as well as the 'Dumfries Octocentenary Trophy' which will be presented to the **Best Entry from a Scottish Club**. In addition SPF Gold Medals will be awarded to Best Entry in each section from a Scottish Resident.

Accepted Prints and Projected Digital Images will be eligible for FIAP honours, Acceptances in Colour Print and Monochrome Print sections will be credited towards Pictorial Print (Large Print) classes for Star Ratings and Who's Who for each section. Acceptances in Nature sections will be credited towards Nature classes for PSA star ratings and 'Who's Who' listing. Acceptances in PID recognised Colour sections shall be credited towards PID Colour Star Ratings and Who's Who Colour listings. Monochrome images accepted in PID recognized color sections shall only be credited towards PID Color star ratings. Monochrome Images accepted in PID recognised Monochrome sections shall be credited towards PID Monochrome Star Ratings and Who's Who Monochrome Listings.

Members of the organising committee are not eligible for any of the above awards. The Panel of Selectors are ineligible to enter any sections of this Salon.
